ID LOGISTICS RECRUITS 300 EMPLOYEES IN THE HAUTS-DE-FRANCE REGION

ID Logistics, a major international player in contract logistics, is strengthening its presence in the Hauts-de-France region by opening a warehouse in Saint-Sauveur (60) for an e-commerce giant, bringing the number of sites in this region to 12. On this occasion, ID Logistics continues its ambitious recruitment plan for 2024 with the creation of 300 new positions.

OPENING OF THE SAINT-SAUVEUR SITE: 300 NEW JOBS CREATED

The Saint-Sauveur site, located in the Les Bornes du Temps business park, covers an area of 84,000 m². The activity began on May 13, 2024.

On the occasion of this opening, ID Logistics is creating 300 new positions, including 250 operational and 50 managerial or support positions (team leaders, logistics department managers, operations managers, HR managers and assistants, QHSE managers and facilitators, IT coordinators, maintenance/IT manager and stock management manager).

Regarding the recruitment of the 250 operational profiles, ID Logistics joined forces with France Travail at the end of February 2024, with the support of the Hauts-de-France Region. Two types of positions were sought: multi-skilled logistics agents for the preparation of orders at height and production operators for ground tasks such as parcel packaging.

Welcomed by the town hall of Saint Sauveur, the teams of ID Logistics and France Travail received 500 job seeker candidates, experienced or novices in logistics during 9 group sessions. To date, 215 profiles matching expectations have been selected. In order to best support its new employees, ID Logistics has adapted its training courses according to their different levels of experience. The beginner profiles received 4 weeks of training in the center, followed by 3 weeks of on-site simulation. Experienced profiles, on the other hand, have benefited from personalised courses according to their experience: CACES® and/or Occupational First Aid accreditations. The first internal training integrations took place on April 22, 2024 and the first permanent hires on April 29, 2024.
