- An eco-responsible site equipped with the latest standards:
  - o A 3.2 MWp photovoltaic power plant on the roof to produce green electricity.
  - o 100% LED lighting with presence detector and light sensor.
  - o A reduction in outdoor lighting to reduce light pollution on the site.
  - o Charging stations for electric vehicles set up in the car park.
  - o Heating by air-to-water heat pump.
  - o A mixed wood/concrete framework to reduce the project's carbon footprint.
  - o Permeable parking areas with draining pavements.
- A preserved neighbouring ecosystem:
  - o 6 hectares protected near the site for 50 years, in order to ensure the ecological balance.
  - The creation of a 1.5-hectare landscaped basin conducive to housing, feeding and the reproduction of biodiversity.
  - o The planting of wide hedges of shrubs and bushy thickets.
  - o The transparency of the permanent fences for the passage of small fauna.
  - o The installation of loopholes on rainwater drains.

### A 1ST ESTABLISHMENT IN FRANCE TO DELIVER ALL OF SOUTHERN EUROPE

The Saint-Rambert-d'Albon site covers more than 9,000 m<sup>2</sup> and has 9 loading docks. The 9,000 references present required rack storage as well as shelves to densify their storage.

It is planned to receive a hundred containers per year, the shipment of 12,000 pallets and the preparation of 78,000 packages. The site also handles customer returns. To do this, the 30 employees on site have been trained in the checking, repair, cleaning and reconditioning of clothes.

This first establishment in France for Stanley/Stella significantly improves delivery times in France and southern European countries.
