ID LOGISTICS GERMANY COMPLETES ITS SERVICE OFFER WITH LAST-MILE DELIVERY FOR E-RETAILERS

From the end of 2024, ID Logistics Germany will add last-mile delivery to its service offering. This new service will initially be implemented for an e-commerce giant at a new location in Hamburg. The international leader in contract logistics will now manage the entire supply chain, from order picking to last-mile delivery.

ID Logistics is expanding its service offering by providing last-mile delivery services for e-commerce in Germany for the first time. A model already proven in various countries of the Group, including France, Spain and the Netherlands, this initiative complements the logistics company's service offering for e-commerce and underlines its position as a leader in contract logistics in Germany, now operating at all levels of the supply chain in the sector.

This new mission will apply as part of a new collaboration with an international e-commerce giant, whose activity will start at the end of 2024 in a new 9,300m² site (including 5,515m² of warehouse), in the port of Hamburg.

The new location of ID Logistics Germany in Hamburg is centrally located in relation to the delivery points served. It will include about thirty operators in charge of receiving goods delivered overnight from distribution centers in charge of the "intermediate kilometer", sorting packages and loading vehicles for delivery to the final consumer. To this end, almost 1 million euros have been invested in the standardization of technical and safety equipment to the ID Logistics standards.

With 15 logistics sites, more than 500,000 m² throughout Germany and around 4,000 employees, ID Logistics Germany manages everyday products such as very fragile cosmetics, as well as heavy and bulky items such as washing machines, refrigerators and freezers, for e-commerce. as well as large televisions, for delivery to the final consumer.
